

Your entry has been accepted for the Jumping Jack Rally 2014. You should report for scrutiny between 19:00 and 19:45. First car will start at 21:01.

Start/Finish/Scrutiny is at The Derryhirk Inn, Aghagallon – Ref 20/088 644

- MAPS** Sheet 14 D or E Edition, and Sheet 20 D or E Edition OSNI 1:50000 Discoverer series. Approximate boundaries are N83 S61 E25 W07.
- CARS** Competitors are reminded that for scrutiny, cars must be taxed and carry a warning triangle, have no more than four forward facing beams, be able to pass a sound check (R4.1) and carry no advertising (R.18.6.1).
- FUEL** Competitors are advised to have sufficient fuel to last the duration of the event, approximately 75 miles. If you need fuel after the rally, the nearest open filling station will be in Moira at reference 20/147 604.
- TIMING** By watches set to BBC time; times will be advised as 'Standard Time' for each control. Thus each competitor adds his 'Competition Number' to the Standard Time to get his due time. E.g. if standard time at TCF is 21:23 then number 26 is due at 21:49.
- NAVIGATION** This will include Map References, Grid Lines, Map Trace, Spot Heights, Herringbone, Clock Face and Tulip Diagrams and variations thereof. Class 4 competitors will get a few sections to pre-plot before the start of the event.
- TRIP** A distance of 1.00 miles has been set up between two QUBMC boards. It starts at 081 644½ SW and finishes at S 073½ 651½.
- REFRESHMENTS** Supper and drinks can be purchased at the finish venue.
- DOCUMENTATION** Classes 1, 2 and 3 competitors will be required to produce:
(a) A current club membership card from any ANICC, MI, ESACC or AWSMSC affiliated club for both driver and navigator.
(b) An MSA Competition Licence valid for this status of event.
Note: If you have not yet applied for your 2014 Competition Licence, you can apply on the night by providing us with the completed form, photograph and payment. This only applies to Non-race National B Licences, but not if you are applying for a stage rally Licence.
If you have applied for your licence, but have not yet received it, you will be liable to be fined for not producing a licence.
- Class 4 competitors will be required to produce:
(a) A current QUBMC membership card.
